PROJECT UPDATES

Water/Sewer Department

Hello,

Just wanted to give everyone in the community an update of the different projects that we have going on in the Water and Sewer Department. There are a lot of great things going on in the City at this present time but I will cover what my department is working on.

I would also like to encourage all Citizens to call me if you have any questions and you are all welcome to come down to the plant and tour the facility and see what we do.

1. The sewer repair project is working over in the Kerron street, Mill street and Shannon lewis lane. They are working on side sewers and main lines. The purpose of this project is to lower our inflow and infiltration of storm water into our sewer system. This project is expected to last around 200 days. **This project is fully covered under a grant.**
2. The sewer plant upgrades are also in full operation. This will upgrade our current treatment plant so that both sides of the plant are operational. This project is expected to last around 200 days and is **fully covered under a grant.**
3. The Galvanized replacement project is in the final stages of the engineering plan. It is scheduled to start this year and it will replace all the galvanized lines down Se first st to Campbell, and in other areas of the city. This will help with the city with its water loss through leaks. It is also the first step in getting the new road and sidewalks built down part of Se 1st st. **This project is fully funded with a grant.**
4. We are in the engineering process to add a new well to our infrastructure. This well will be located about ¼ mile east of the grand prairie estates. This project is slated to be started this year. **This is a project fully funded from cardinal glass.**
5. We are in the engineering stages to run a water line out to Knowles road. This is part of a process to get service out to the industrial area. This project will hopefully be started this year. **Phase 1 of this project is fully funded by the State of Washington .** The next phase will be to run sewer out to Knowles road and then complete the road to the industrial park. The goal is to have this done within this next 4 years. Once this is done then we will be able to attract businesses to the park.
